

There are two sizes of Mister Potato Head, regular and baby potato head. And these parts come in different sizes too. It's always a joy to watch them figure out which shoes fit best for each size.



They quickly realize that small shoes do not work well with the larger potato, since it makes it tip over. Plus, this toy is great for helping younger children develop their **fine motor skills** as they work on fitting the pieces into the holes of the potato.



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
