It's amazing how this toy has stayed popular over the years. The children in the Playroom are discovering just how much fun this toy can be. They really enjoy creating different kinds of people with the various eyes, mouths, noses, hair, hats, and shoes. Have you ever seen a nose that looked like an ear? Or a person with three or four arms? **There is no limit to what their imagination can create.**







Not only is this toy a lot of fun, but it can also be educational. The children love figuring out where the eyes and mouth should go on the face. There are two sizes of Mister Potato Head, regular and baby potato head. And these parts come in different sizes too. It's always a joy to watch them figure out which shoes fit best for each size.



They quickly realize that small shoes do not work well with the larger potato, since it makes it tip over. Plus, this toy is great for helping younger children develop their **fine motor skills** as they work on fitting the pieces into the holes of the potato.






WELCOME BACK VANESSA!
