



News From the Playroom



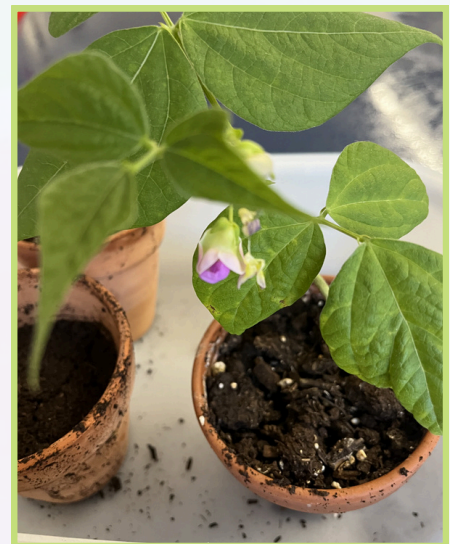

HEPATITIS A

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Hepatitis A is a virus that affects the liver and spreads from one person to another through contact orally or through the stool (poop) of an infected person. It can make people sick for a few weeks or even months. In serious cases, it can lead to hospitalization and may be life-threatening

How is it spread



An infected person can spread Hepatitis A if they do not wash their hands properly after using the bathroom



Hepatitis A can be spread through sexual contact with someone who is infected



It can be spread by eating or drinking food or water that has been contaminated with the virus

Symptoms of Hepatitis A



Fever



Jaundice (yellow skin or eyes)



Dark urine (pee), pale poop or diarrhea

Prevention



Always wash your hands with soap and water. Especially before eating, making food, and after using the bathroom.



Get your Hepatitis A vaccine

Contact your Health Care Provider if you think you have Hepatitis A

From Our Community



"When we moved to Winnipeg in 2024, everything was new to us. We had no family nearby, no close friends, and no support system around us. Then, in August 2025, our daughter Maya was born. Like many first-time parents, we wanted to give her all our love and attention – and we did. But the reality of caring for a newborn completely on our own, day and night, was emotionally and physically exhausting.

For months, my wife and I spent virtually every hour focused on Maya's care. We loved every moment with her, but we also slowly realized how important it is for parents to have even a small moment to breathe, recharge, and feel supported. Without family nearby, that kind of support felt impossible to find.

Then we discovered Acorn Family Place. For us, Acorn became much more than just a community centre. It became a safe and welcoming place where we could finally relax for a few hours while knowing Maya was in caring and capable hands.

The playroom, the trained early childhood educators, and the warm environment immediately gave us comfort and trust. Maya had the chance to play, explore, and socialize with other children, while we could simply sit in the drop-in space, breathe, and feel human again.



Those few hours meant more to us than words can fully describe. They gave us emotional relief, reassurance, and a sense that we were not alone anymore. As newcomers to Winnipeg and as new parents, Acorn gave us something we deeply needed: community, support, and peace of mind.

We are truly grateful for the kindness and care we found at Acorn Family Place. For families like ours, it is not just a place for children to play – it is a place where parents can feel supported, connected, and hopeful."
